




## Reader for PC

### Installing the Software


1. [Click here](#) to download Reader for PC.
2. The installation procedure varies depending on your browser:
  - a. In Internet Explorer, click **Run** in the download bar at the bottom of the page.



- b. In Chrome, choose a location to save the file, then click **Save**. When the download is complete, click on **ReaderInstaller.exe** in the download bar at the bottom of the page.




- c. In Firefox, click **Save** file. When the download is complete, click on the downloads button in the navigation bar, then click on **ReaderInstaller.exe**.



3. The installation of Reader for PC will start. Click **Run** to confirm.
4. Choose your country in the country selection window, then click **Next**, then **Next** again.

5. Check the box “I accept the terms in the license agreement,” then click **Next**.



6. Click **Next**, then **Install**.
7. When the installation is complete, click **Finish** to close the software installation. Reader for PC will start automatically.

## Borrow and Load eBooks

1. The Library Finder can be found at: <http://sonysearch.overdrive>  
**NOTE:** To find out more information and if your public library offers free downloads, enter your zip code or state into the **Search Libraries** field of the Library Finder.
2. Once you locate a book and download it, you should get a pop-up message that will ask to **Run** or **Save** the file. If the Reader software is installed, once you click **Run**, the book will be downloaded into the Reader software. If you click **Save**, you will need to locate the file and then double-click it.  
**NOTE:** Files saved to the computer will be saved as a URL file in the Windows operating system or an ACSM file in the Apple® Mac OS® operating system.
3. Open the Reader software.
4. Click the **Library** tab.
5. You should see the book you just borrowed in your library now.
6. The next time you synchronize, the book will be transferred to your Reader device.
